CAPM® Credential

The Certified Associate in Project Management (CAPM®) credential is designed for professionals who provide specialized skills to a project team, for aspiring project managers and for graduate and undergraduate students who are studying project management. The credential can benefit a wide range of team members and specialists who want to demonstrate a comprehensive understanding of project management good practices. By gaining knowledge of project management processes and terminology, professionals from all disciplines can reach higher levels of performance in their work.

Specific education and experience requirements, agreement to adhere to a code of professional conduct and the passing of a multiple-choice question exam are required to be eligible. The Project Management Body of Knowledge (*PMBOK® Guide*) is PMI®'s standards document outlining generally accepted knowledge and practices of project management. PMI® has shared intentions to update its standards every five years.

PMI-ACP® Credential

The Agile Certified Practitioner (PMI-ACP®) is new from PMI and is designed for practitioners who utilize Agile

approaches to project management in their projects. The credential can benefit a wide range of individuals who have experience working on agile projects; as it is not limited to project managers or PMP® credential holders. Obtaining this credential demonstrates a level of professionalism in agile practices of project management, and increases professional versatility in both Waterfall and agile techniques.
